Message from Mrs. Yadoff

If your child is sick with COVID19 compatible symptoms, which can be similar to the common cold, a doctor's note is necessary to clear the student to return to school, along with a negative COVID19 test.

From the Nurses Office

This is a friendly reminder. Please do not send your children to school if they are not feeling well and/or have "cold-like" symptoms. These symptoms include but are not limited to: runny nose, nasal congestion, headache, cough, sore throat, stomachache, body aches, fatigue or fever. Some of these symptoms are COVID19 compatible symptoms and cannot be differentiated from the "common cold" symptoms without COVID19 testing. The district is continuing to ask for a negative COVID19 test and doctors note clearing students to return to school for one symptom. If you keep your child home for any of these symptoms please have your child seen by his/her doctor before sending them back to school. In order to efficiently move through the parking lot, all families must follow the outlined procedures. To improve the parking lot traffic with immediate effect, we are reminding you of the following:

- All 7th Grade families should pick up and drop off their students from the side baseball field parking lot. During dismissal, once all students are safely in the building, you may begin entering that lot.
- **AM Drop Off** - in the morning, all 6th and 8th grade families must pull all the way to the end of the horseshoe driveway REGARDLESS of whether or not there are cars behind you. We added new signage to make this point more visible.
