<p>Score of 3 (Meets)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Engages and orients the reader by establishing a context and point of view and introducing a narrator and/or characters; organize an event sequence that unfolds naturally and logically ● Uses precise language consistently, including descriptive words and phrases, sensory details, linking and transitional words, words to indicate tone, and/or domain specific vocabulary ● Uses narrative techniques, such as dialogue, pacing, description, and reflection, to develop experiences, events, and/or characters.
